Re. Review of Hidalgo County's Indigent Defense Systems

Below are the responses to the findings and recommendations regarding the site visit of Hidalgo County's Indigent Defense Systems conducted February 9-13, 2009.

1. Contract Attorney for Juvenile Detention Hearings

Hidalgo County is now using a rotational system for appointing counsel at juvenile detention hearings.

Completion date: September, 2009

2. Juvenile Plan

Management will work with the board of judges to list the required times for appointment of juvenile counsel. The juvenile plan will be updated with the new indigent defense plan submission due November 1.

Completion date: November, 2009

3. Juvenile detention hearing form

Management will work with the board of judges to review the current procedure for tracking detention hearings.

Completion date: December, 2009

4. Appointed Juvenile Attorney Must Represent Their Clients at Detention Hearing.

With the move to rotational system for juvenile detention hearings, this is no longer an issue.

5. Attorney Selection Process

The board of judges will annually review the distribution of attorney appointments to ensure that they are made in a fair, neutral, and non-discriminatory manner.
